Lethal blood loss, On December 19, 2016, Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) in Gjoa Haven received reports that Charles Qirngnirq was upset and had gone to the airport with a rifle. RCMP officers located Charles at the airport and saw him walk away from the airport with a rifle. The officers perceived an imminent threat to their lives, and one of them fired a single shot at Charles. The shot struck Charles and he later died of loss of blood from his injuries.

Addressed to the RCMP:

- 1. The RCMP will require all officers stationed in Nunavut to receive regular and validated suicide prevention training, to help them better understand how to respond to suicidal thoughts and expressions they may encounter.
- 2. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) will equip police vehicles in Nunavut with spotlight and vehicle light bars that can be used to located or better see subjects at a distance and in low light conditions.
- **3.** The RCMP will require all officers stationed in Nunavut to receive regular mandatory regular trauma response training in addition to basic first aid.

- 4. The RCMP will equip detachments and police and police vehicles in Nunavut with first aid kits properly supplied to respond to life threatening wounds.
- 5. The RCMP can equip police vehicles in Nunavut with longer cords for loudhailer microphones suitable to arctic conditions to improve safe communication with subjects.
- **6.** The RCMP will equip detachments and police vehicles in Nunavut with scopes or binoculars to magnify subjects at a distance and in low light conditions.

Addressed the Government of Nunavut Hamlet of Gjoa Haven:

- 1. Public places with surveillance cameras should be properly maintained
- 2. The Department of Health, GN, will ensure that all community health centers across the territory are equipped with pelvic guards for use in the treatment of traumatic injuries.
- 3. The Department of Health, GN, will review its current system of maintaining blood supplies in regional centers to see if the more blood can be made available to more locations.
- 4. The Department of Health, GN, and the Hamlet of Gjoa Haven will prioritize starting a young mens' group to promote well-being and health in the community.
- 5. Having more then one Mental Health Nurse and out reach employee in each community in Nunavut.
