Addressed to the RCMP:

- The RCMP will review and revise training to ensure officers and civilian guards seek medical assistance when dealing with persons who are minimally responsive, regardless of whether intoxication is a factor.
- The RCMP will review and revise Operational Manual 19.2 to require a medical
 assessment, not only where there are signs of having sustained a head injury, but
 also where the circumstances of arrest and detention indicate possible head injury.
- 3. The RCMP will review and revise training to ensure officers and civilian guards have a solid understanding of the need to seek immediate medical attention for "semi-

conscious" prisoners, emphasizing that reduced consciousness due to intoxication does not affect the need for medical assessment.

- 4. The RCMP will provide and require RCMP officers in Nunavut to wear body cameras to document interactions with civilians to increase transparency and build trust between the RCMP members and community members.
- 5. The RCMP will require RCMP officers working in Nunavut to undertake regular sensitivity training to ensure respectful interactions and treatment of civilians, notwithstanding actions deemed necessary for officer safety and the safety of the public.

Addressed to the Government of Nunavut:

- 6. The GN will review cardiac and trauma life support training requirements for nurses who provide emergency medical care in Nunavut, with a view to ensuring all community health centres have staff with up-to-date certification in advanced cardiac and trauma life support.
- 7. The GN will confirm the existence of rigid styluses in all community health centres in Nunavut and review and consider supplying community health centres throughout Nunavut with fiber optic laryngoscopes, as well as appropriate physician training.
- 8. The GN will review policy relating to a third party cancellation of the need for medical assistance. When a call is placed to the health centre for medical assistance, the call should remain active until such time that a medical assessment has been conducted either over the phone or in person with the client, regardless of information from a third party.

Addressed to the Hamlet of Kugluktuk:

- The Hamlet of Kugluktuk will review the protocols relating to by-law enforcement, to ensure by-law officers do not engage in the arrest and transport of prisoners, in the absence of policies, training and equipment equivalent to standards required of RCMP officers.
- 10. The Hamlet of Kugluktuk will generate a policy of standard operating procedures for by-law officers which will include the duties, reporting, required training, and required equipment. The Hamlet will ensure the duties, responsibilities and authority of by-law officers are communicated to the community.
- 11. The Hamlet of Kugluktuk will seek legal advice regarding the authority of by-law officers to make arrests and have proper protocols in place with the RCMP for the arrest and transport of prisoners.

Addressed to the Hamlet of Kugluktuk and the Government of Nunavut

12. The Hamlet of Kugluktuk and the Government of Nunavut will review the policy relating to the purpose and use of the ambulance to ensure that it is equipped and staffed accordingly.
