AS A RESULT OF AN INQUEST INTO THE DEATH HELD ON 9th day of November, 2018 AT Hamlet of Pond Inlet IN NUNAVUT							
THE JURORS HAVE CONSIDERED THE EVIDENCE AND MAKE THE FOLLOWING DETERMINATIONS

6. CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH DEATH OCCURRED: Λτος τορο Δοιστάρος Δειστάρος LCC: In the event taken place of March 18, 2017. The RCMP Members and David Kumuk Qajaakutuk Qamaniq had an altercation which resulted in a shooting. David Kunuk Qajaakutuk Qamaniq died of a result of single Gun Shot through the neck, the bullet had penetrated in left collar bone, through the spinal cord and finally existing back of right upper shoulder blade. This resulted David Kunuk Qajaakutuk Qamaniq losing too much blood at the Pond Inlet Health Centre and to be pronounced dead at 8:05pm

- That the Government of Nunavut Mental Health and Addictions, Government of Nunavut Quality
 of Life and Embrace Life Council partner with the Hamlet of Pond Inlet and relevant local Elder,
 youth and other community organizations to develop a suicide prevention community engagement
 and empowerment program that supports the community of Pond Inlet to plan and take action
 locally with a customized program including ongoing follow-up support.
- 2. That the Government of Nunavut Department of Health proactively collaborate with the Hamlet of Pond Inlet and relevant non-government organizations to support the establishment of a local counselor training program similar to Ilisaqsivik's Our Life's Journey Program including support for ongoing training, program review and updating.

- That the Hamlet of Pond Inlet together with any relevant local Elder, youth and other community
 councils or organizations request funding and support from the Government of Nunavut Quality of
 Life or Embrace Life Council to develop community-designed and delivered intervention skills
 workshops.
- 4. The Government of Nunavut Department of Health, Mental Health and Addictions Division, will proactively engage with regional Inuit organizations to design and deliver cultural competency training that includes education on the history of Inuit, including the findings of the Qikiqtani Truth Commission and Truth and Reconciliation Commission, for all mental health nurses and mental health outreach workers.
- 5. That the Government of Nunavut Department of Health, Quality of Life and local front line health service providers including the RCMP and Education Districts, develop and implement expanded interdepartmental and interagency information sharing protocols (IISPs) to identify and support individuals at risk of harming self or others and who may need early intervention supports.
- 6. That the Government of Nunavut and RCMP could develop an effective and robust Inuit recruitment plan to increase the number of Inuit members in the RCMP.
- 7. Living matter first; this has be to recognized by all professionals of any involvements in first responders, this includes Government of Nunavut, RCMP, Mental Health, Social Workers and any support staff that may be appointed by any employer
- That Hamlet of Pond Inlet create a steering committee in the development of assisting in area of Mental Health, and the members can and be able to provide services in counselling to any member of Pond Inlet.
- 9. In relations to Action Plan 2017-2022 INUUSIVUT ANNINATUQ; All partner amend the statement of Our Shared Commitments; #6. We will communicate with Nunavutmiut about prevention and our progress to include community visits to update progress of the strategy
- 10. In any case of patient is brought in traumatic state, member of parent or guardian be given an opportunity to observe within the Department of Health
- 11. That the RCMP, in collaboration with the GN, revitalize the special constable program and hire local Inuit to these positions.
